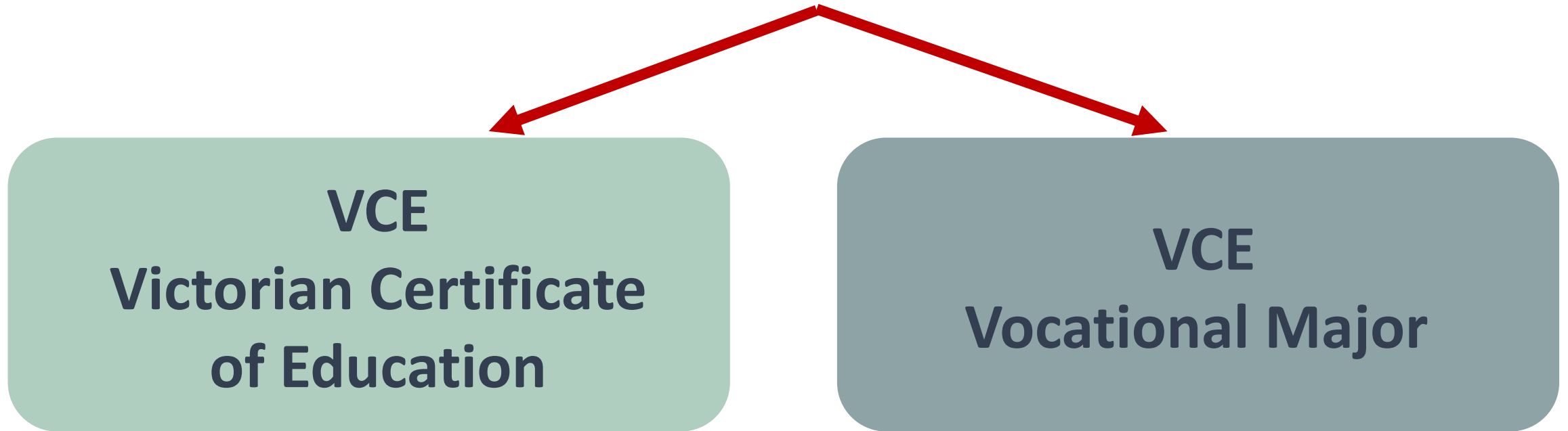

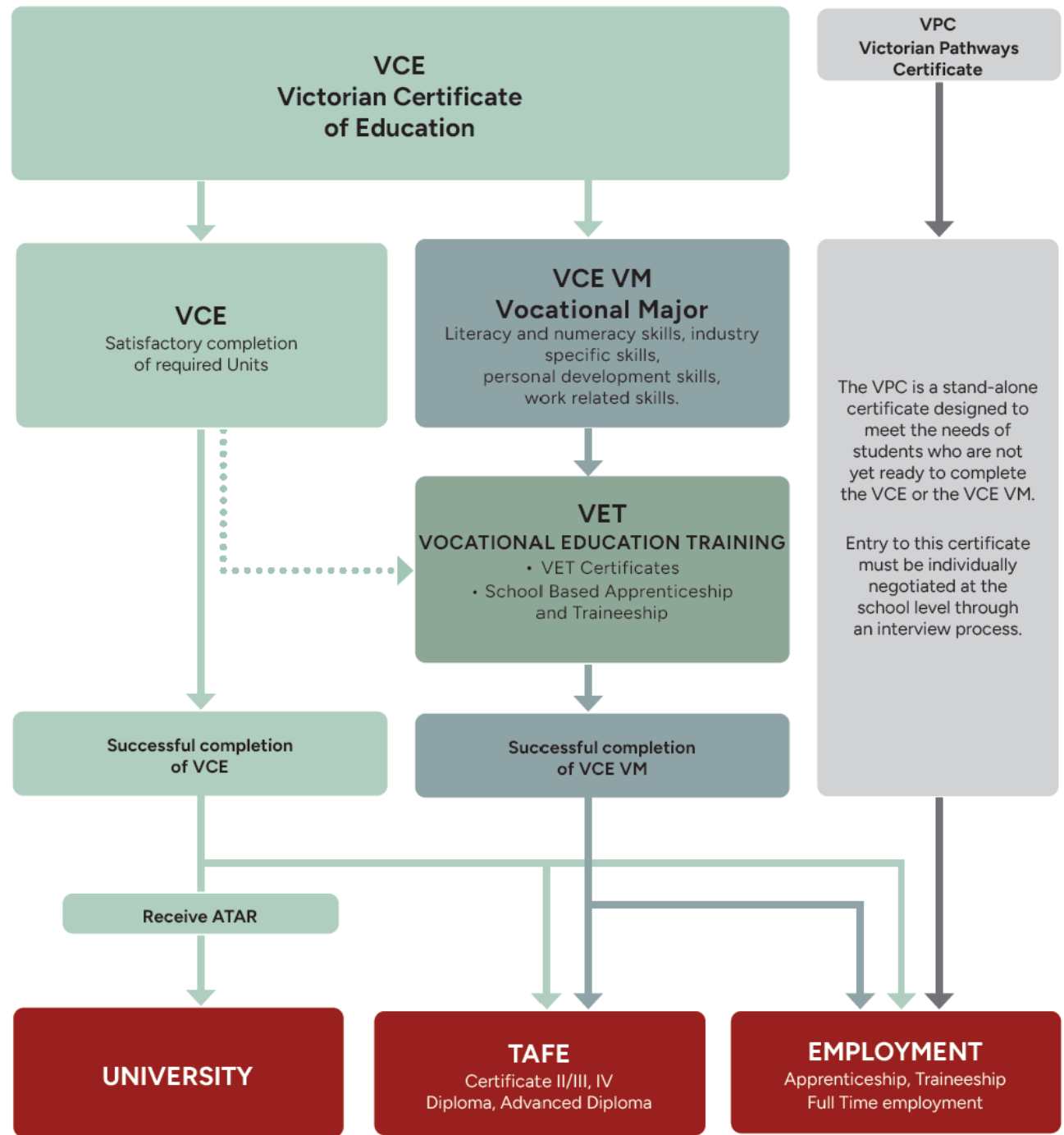
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# Victorian Certificate of Education

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# What is VCE?

- Year 12 students across Victoria will attain the Victorian Certificate of Education
- VCE is based on school assessments and external examinations.
- Students receive an Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) for entrance into tertiary education.
- VCE VM students can choose VCE subjects but need to be aware of the impact of out-of-school time on their studies.



# Completion of VCE

**Successfully complete a minimum of 20-24 units including:**

- Three English units – English and/or Literature
- One English Unit 3/4 sequence

## **+ PLUS**

- Three other Unit 3/4 sequences
- 8 or more other units

**Trinity program exceeds the VCAA minimum requirement to ensure VCE completion. Any alteration to expectations would be discussed.**



# Unit 1-4 VCE Completion



## Satisfactory or Not Satisfactory

- Assessed for each outcome/area of study.
- Report the S or N to VCAA by designated dates.
- Unit completion includes class activities, School Assessment Coursework and Tasks (SACs & SATs), attendance and exams.

# Unit 1 and Unit 2 in Year 11

- Must choose English and/or Literature.
- Must choose RE.

## + PLUS

- Four other Unit 1 and Unit 2 (and reserves).
- Sequences are chosen but these can change.





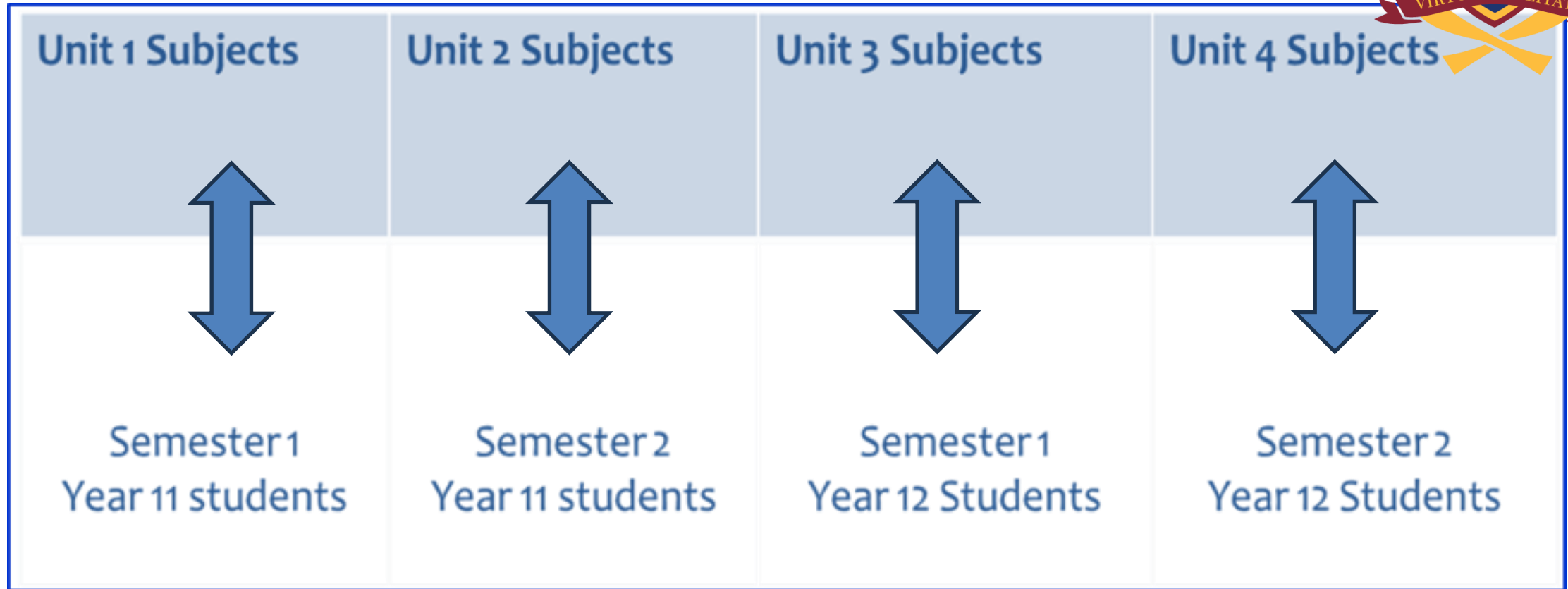

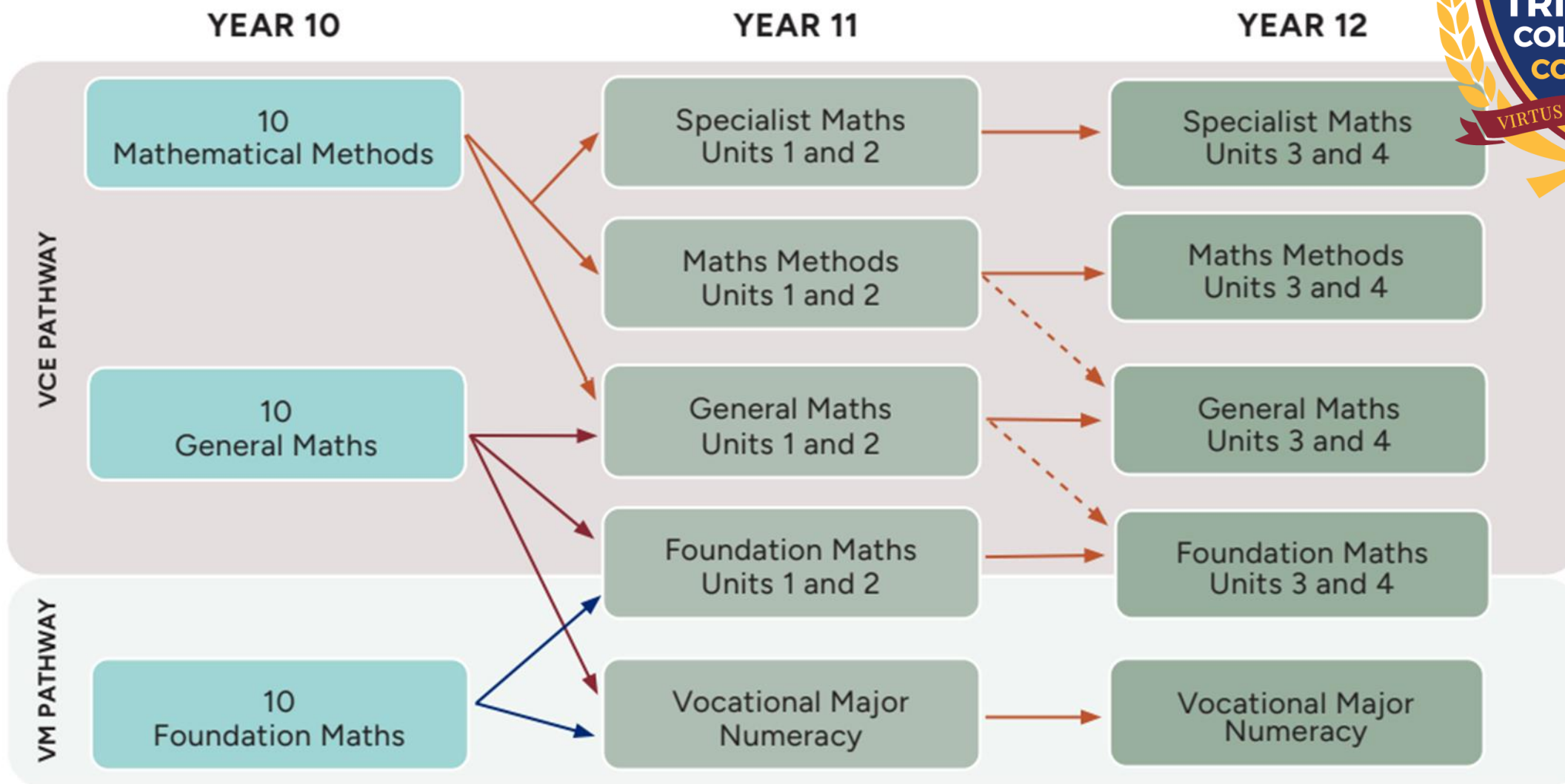

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# What is VCE Vocational Major?



- Applied learning, practical, work-related pathway.
- Competency based assessments, no formal exams.
- Largely project based curriculum.
- Develops literacy, numeracy and personal skills relevant to life and work.
- Gets you out and about in the community: Structured Work Placements, School Based Apprenticeships, Traineeships, TAFE Courses, and Community Projects.

# Completion of VCE VM



Requires students to successfully complete 16 units in total delivered in a Unit 1 to 4 sequence across 2 years.

## The 16 units must include:

- 3 VCE VM Literacy or VCE English units (including a Unit 3-4 sequence).
- 2 VCE VM Numeracy or VCE Mathematics units.
- 2 VCE VM Work Related Skills units (now compulsory).
- 2 VCE VM Personal Development Skills units.
- 2 VET credits at Certificate II level or above (180 nominal hours).

**At least 3 other unit 3-4 sequences (can be VCE, VCE VM, or VET).**

Suited to students interested in continuing training or moving into full time employment:

- **TAFE Courses**
- **Apprenticeships**
- **Traineeships**
- **Full-Time Employment**

# VET Certificates

VCE VM students MUST complete 180 hours of VET.

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# What is VET?

- Operates as part of VCE or VCE – VM Pathways.
- Can include work placement and hands-on experience.
- Some courses may add to your ATAR.
- Competency-based assessment.
- Usually a 2-year course.





# What is VET?

- Gives students a good insight into industries and many of our students move from a VET Course into a School Based Apprenticeship or Traineeship or full time employment.
- Offers 'hands-on' practical training with less theory-based learning.
- Students will gain skills required to move into the workforce.

**If you plan on studying VCE VM  
YOU MUST undertake at least ONE VET subject**

No allocation can be made for this subject in the timetable, therefore schoolwork missed must be made up outside class time.
- Interested students **MUST** make an appointment with Mrs Julie Demasi (VET Coordinator) to discuss further.
- **Costs** involved which is additional to school fees.
- **Applications will open early August for external VET options with South West TAFE and The Gordon.**
- **Applications need to be completed as soon as possible as courses fill quickly**

# School Based Apprenticeships and Traineeships (SBAT)

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# What is a SBAT?

- School Based Apprenticeships/Traineeships (SBAT) allows students to combine their secondary studies with paid part-time employment as an apprentice or traineeship in their chosen industry.
- Traditionally, they are undertaken in Years 11 & 12 whilst students are completing their Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE) or Victorian Certificate of Education Vocational Major (VCE - VM) qualification.



# What is a SBAT?

- A SBAT provides students with 'hands-on' industry experience and the ability to work towards a nationally recognised qualification, whilst completing their secondary school certificate.
- Part of an SBAT involves students undertaking vocational training. This is provided by a Registered Training Organisation (RTO).



# SBAT Eligibility

- Students must be at least 15 years of age to undertake a SBAT and undertaking either VCE or VCE VM.
- SBAT's are discussed individually with students and their parents to make sure students are ready to undertake a SBAT.

# Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR)

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# ATAR



- Unit 3/4 Study Score (out of 50) is scaled.
- These scaled marks are added together to provide the student's ATAR.
  - English studies (English/Literature)
  - and next best 3 subjects
  - Plus 10% of fifth and sixth subjects

The ATAR is a ranking used to determine students' accessibility into tertiary courses.

# VET Subjects link to ATAR

- VET subjects with a scored assessment exam (such as VET Sport and Recreation) are scored just like any other VCE subject to contribute to your ATAR
- VET subjects without a scored assessment exam (such as VET Agriculture) are calculated using 10% of the lowest study score of your primary four.

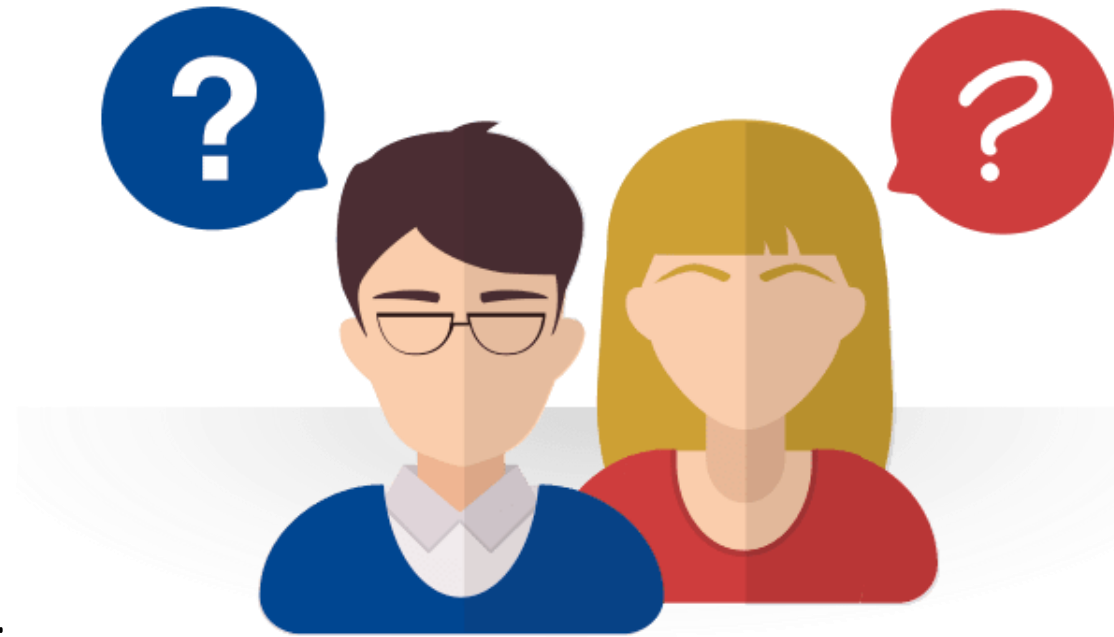
